

What's the connection between heartburn and esophageal cancer?

If you have persistent heartburn or chronic acid reflux, also known as GERD, your doctor may have discussed the need for an endoscopy to look at your esophagus. GERD can lead to a precancerous condition known as Barrett's esophagus, which, in a small percentage of people, may progress to esophageal cancer if left unchecked.

Detecting precancer is the key to prevention.

When unhealthy, precancerous cells are detected early, they can be removed before they can turn into cancer.

Insurance and Medicare coverage

The specialized WATS^{3D} laboratory analysis of the tissue obtained during an endoscopy is a covered benefit under many medical insurance plans.

If your doctor performs a WATS^{3D} procedure and sends the tissue to CDx Diagnostics for analysis, in the coming weeks, you will receive an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from your insurance company. **The EOB is not a bill.**

In-Network Plans: If CDx has a contract with your medical insurance company, we are contractually obligated to bill standard co-pays, co-insurance and/or deductibles which your plan views as patient responsibility. These plans include Medicare and Medicare Advantage.

Out-of-Network Plans: If CDx does not have a contract with your medical insurance company, you will not be responsible for the cost of services that aren't covered by your plan.

The No Surprises Act: We note in addition that under the Federal No Surprises Act ancillary providers (e.g., pathology, radiology) may not balance bill patients, and payors must treat all claims as if they were in-network.




